



Crescent searches for Chinese gold

Crescent Gold has been granted permission to look for gold in western China, near the Kazakhstan border. The approval, awarded to a company 95.5 per cent indirectly owned by Crescent, will allow Crescent and its Chinese partner into a previously unexplored area that sits among some of the world's largest gold and gold-copper deposits. Crescent plans to get straight to work with a geochemical and geophysical survey next month. **AAP**
